We offer a wonderful Transitional Kindergarten program with teachers who understand the needs of young children. Thus we can help each child grow and thrive in his or her social / emotional, cognitive, and physical development.

We provide experiences in literature, math, science, art, music, dramatic play, motor development, chapel, and outdoor activities.

Our program offers:

- experienced teachers
- small class sizes (2 teachers with a maximum of 18 children)
- 1 hour of outdoor time on our playgrounds, patios, and in our gardens
- ♦ A 3-hour class
 - with 2-, 3-, and 5-day options
 - before- and after-school care
- Our program provides the opportunity for a "bonus year" for children who turn 5 years of age during the summer

Children will eat lunch and play outside until 2:00 then come inside for a short quiet time. Then they will enjoy free play until 3:00.

Children who are enrolled in our Enrichment class may also stay until 3:00. When enrichment ends at 2:00, the children will be escorted to our Lunch Bunch group.

Motor Development

Class— Each class attends a Motor Development class a few times each month.

Motor Development is held in our Fellowship Hall.

It is a special class using



special equipment that helps in the development of large motor skills.

The philosophy of <u>The Outdoor Classroom</u> is "anything you can do indoors, you can do better outdoors." Besides our raised garden beds and being part of the Pacific Corridor for Monarch butterflies, we introduce children to concepts of recycling, upcycling, reducing and reusing, and water conservation. They also have fun on our wonderful playgrounds, patios, and in our gardens playing (and looking for bugs and lizards).
